a lotta lotsa	a lot of lots of	I have <b>a lotta</b> books at home. = I have <b>a lot of</b> books at home. = I have <b>lotsa</b> books at home. = I have <b>lots of</b> books at home. У меня дома <b>много</b> книг.
ain't	am not, are not, is not, has not, have not	I'd love to leave my door unlocked when I leave the house, but this <b>ain't</b> Canada. Я бы хотел оставлять свою дверь незапертой, когда выхожу из дома, но это <b>не</b> Канада.
c'mon	come on	<b>C'mon</b> , don't be so captious! She is a loyal friend. = <b>Come on</b> , don't be so captious! <b>Да ладно</b> , не будь таким придирчивым! Она верный друг.
cuppa	cup of	I wanna <b>cuppa</b> tea. = I want a <b>cup of</b> tea. Я хочу чашку чая.
cuz = 'cos = 'coz = 'cause	because	I don't like these candies ' <b>cos</b> /' <b>coz</b> /' <b>cause</b> / <b>cuz</b> they are too sweet. = I don't like these candies <b>because</b> they are too sweet. Я не люблю эти конфеты, <b>потому что</b> они слишком сладкие.



didja	did you	<b>Didja</b> buy salt yesterday? = <b>Did you</b> buy salt yesterday? Ты вчера купил соль?
dunno	do not know	— What is John's favourite colour? — Какой у Джона любимый цвет? — I <b>dunno</b> . = I <b>do not know</b> . — Я <b>не знаю</b> .
gimme	give me	<b>Gimme</b> your pen. = <b>Give me</b> your pen. <b>Дай мне</b> свою ручку.
gonna	going to	I'm not <b>gonna</b> play tennis with you. = I'm not <b>going to</b> play tennis with you. Я не <b>собираюсь</b> играть с тобой в теннис.
gotta	(have) got to (have) got a	You <b>gotta</b> note it. = You <b>have got to</b> note it. — Ты <b>должен</b> записать это. <b>Has</b> she <b>gotta</b> suitcase? = <b>Has</b> she <b>got a</b> suitcase? — У нее <b>есть</b> чемодан?
hafta/hasta	have to / has to	I <b>hafta</b> go, my boss is waiting for me. = I <b>have to</b> go, my boss is waiting for me. Я <b>должен</b> идти, мой босс меня ждет.
init	isn't it	It's awesome, <b>init</b> ? = It's awesome, <b>isn't it</b> ? Это превосходно, <b>не так ли?</b>
kinda	kind of kind of something	She <b>kinda</b> loves him. = She <b>kind of</b> loves him. — Она <b>вроде</b> любит его. What <b>kinda</b> person are you? = What <b>kind of</b> person are you? — Что ты за человек? (Какой ты <b>тип</b> человека?)
lemme	let me	<b>Lemme</b> take it. = <b>Let me</b> take it. <b>Позволь мне</b> взять это.
needa	need to	I <b>needa</b> leave now. = I <b>need to</b> leave now. Мне сейчас <b>нужно</b> уйти.
oughta	ought to	You <b>oughta</b> buy pizza for me. = You <b>ought to</b> buy pizza for me. Тебе <b>следует</b> купить мне пиццу.



outta	out of	We have just come <b>outta</b> library. = We have just come <b>out of</b> library. Мы только что пришли <b>из</b> библиотеки.
shoulda	should have	You <b>shoulda</b> told me about the rules. = You <b>should have</b> told me about the rules. Тебе <b>следовало</b> сказать мне о правилах.
sorta	sort of	I'm <b>sorta</b> excited about the trip. = I'm <b>sort of</b> excited about the trip. Я <b>немного</b> / <b>в какой-то степени</b> взволнован поездкой.
supposeta	supposed to	You were <b>supposeta</b> buy sugar yesterday. = You were <b>supposed to</b> buy sugar yesterday. Ты <b>должен был</b> купить сахар вчера.
tell 'em	tell them	<b>Tell 'em</b> I am going to leave at 9 p.m. = <b>Tell them</b> I am going to leave at 9 p.m. <b>Скажи им</b> , я собираюсь уйти в 9 вечера.
useta	used to	I <b>useta</b> get up early when I was a child. = I <b>used to</b> get up early when I was a child. У меня <b>была привычка</b> вставать рано, когда я был ребенком.
wanna	want to want a	Do you <b>wanna</b> go home? = Do you <b>want to</b> go home? — Ты <b>хочешь</b> пойти домой? I <b>wanna</b> cup of tea. = I <b>want a</b> cup of tea. — Я <b>хочу</b> чашку чая.
whatcha	what are you	<b>Whatcha</b> doing here? = <b>What are you</b> doing here? <b>Что ты</b> здесь делаешь?
ya = y'	you	Thank <b>ya</b> for the flowers and cake! = Thank <b>y'</b> for the flowers and cake! = Thank <b>you</b> for the flowers and cake! Спасибо <b>тебе</b> за цветы и торт!
