#1 Adrenaline Rush



#2 Euro Trip

You can do it in a car, you can do it in a **campervan**, you can do it on a bus, but going out and experiencing North America **on the road**, because a lot of it is connected through roads and it's really set up for road tripping. There's a lot of camps and **provincial** parks, and national parks to go visit in both Canada and the US.

#5 Thailand

Thailand is your beginner backpack travel center. It's super easy to get around it. You can learn how to scuba dive in many-many places around the world, that have **coral reefs**. And you should definitely do it as soon as possible.

#9 Greek Island Hopping

There's a lot of different islands in Greece and it is a perfect **destination** for anybody in Europe, and anybody, basically, around the world. In their 20s there's a lot of parties, there are lots of beaches, there are lots of cool activities and fun things to do on all the different Greek islands. Each of them has its own **flair**. We've actually just finished the Greek island trip as my last trip I **ended up** taking in my 20s.

#10 Jungle Adventure
